The Parish Council continues to try to improve the Highways and Parking issues which remain a concern in the community. Following discussions with East Riding of Yorkshire Council bollards have been installed at Edwin's Garth to discourage



pavement parking, and road markings put opposite the Church wall to discourage parking where the road is narrow
